Our President Ken Mahoney opened the meeting promptly at 7:04PM

Ricky brought up that he had sent off the AMA packet that contained charter membership and insurance for the club last week, he called Ms. Lois Mock with AMA today to confirm that she received it; she said she had it on her desk.

Glenn brought up painting the exterior of club house. Ricky was "volunteered" to recruit help to paint the club house. Club house needs to be pressure washed first, let dry and then be painted. Roy offered his pressure washer and paint sprayer to use on the project.
