Spence called on the Treasurer to give the monthly report. Gene rose and read the report to the membership. There were no questions and Spence called for the approval of the report as read. The membership voted to approve it.

Spence then called on the membership to approve the minutes of the last meeting as they were received by the membership.

The members voted to accept the minutes as received.

ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Spence asked if there were any special announcements to be made: Dennis reminded everyone that the Lake City Flyin was this coming Saturday 9-27-08, and that the members should make an effort to go to it. The Lake City Fliers always come to our Flyins and we should return the favor. They always have great prizes and give aways to the registered pilots. They also provide a good meal, served very efficiently. With no further announcements we moved on.

GROUNDS COMMITTEE:

Bob reported that the sign at Old Hwy 6 needs repairing or replacement. Gene asked Phillip of the signs committee what he had to report. Phillip stated that he had gone to Bill, of Bill's Signs and got an estimate. A new sign would be \$500.00 installed. This was kicked around some and it was decided to wait till after the November flyin to decide on a sign, either home made or bought before the May flyin in 09. The business was tabled till then.

OLD BUSINESS:

Gene asked Bob about mowing this week, Both Bob and Spence said that grass had not grown and we could skip the mowing this week.

The sign was discussed some more but left until after the new year to be decided on. That concluded the old business discussion.

NEW BUSINESS:

Spencer asked if any new business had to be discussed; Bobby took the floor to talk about the new grill. It was left dirty after the Flyin on the 13th. Bobby explained that the cook for that day should not be responsible for the cleaning after working all day cooking. He suggested that there be a designated person responsible for cleaning. Most parts that need cleaning are removable and can be taken home to clean. That's what Bobby did this time. Everyone agreed that this was a good idea and we will do it for the scheduled Flyins in the future.

Nelson spoke of having a fish fry for the club members. He asked Bobby and Spencer for some fish to fry. Both said that they would donate enough fish to have the fry. Nelson will pick a date and notify the members when it will be,

Wayne Flowers took the floor and spoke of a 20 ft container he has and would donate it to the club if they would pay for the moving of it. He also has a set of bleachers if the club was interested. Wayne said we would need a flat bed to move the container as it weighs about 3 to 4 thousand pounds. If we could get it to the field, he would bring his tractor up to move it into position on the field. Wayne knows someone who might move it for us; there were several other members who know someone who would bring it up from Wayne's place. It should be set on timbers or blocks to get it off the ground. Wayne is to look into it and notify Gene as to costs. Gene was given permission by the membership to make the necessary funds available for the project. Wayne will get in touch with Gene and work out the details. The Officers will be kept informed.

CRASH AWARD NOMINATION:

There were two nominees for the award, Dennis for his Kadet and Gene for his Tribute. Gene was voted to get the award. He explained that the aircraft got into the sun on the East side of the field and he lost control. Pilot error all the way, no excuses.

At this point Spencer ask for a motion to close the meeting. Meeting ended at 1925 hrs.
