Our President Ken Mahoney opened the meeting promptly at 3:00PM

### **GROUNDS COMMITTEE REPORT:**

Phillip mentioned that on average we usually cut the field 30 to 33 times a year. Ken said if the club was to hire a grass cutting outfit, our dues would surely go up with only having 25 paying members to cover the cost.
