Our President Ken Mahoney opened the meeting promptly at 7:01PM

Ken welcomed the members and guests. Gene Guthan, our Treasurer, was not present at the meeting. Ken handed out copies of the Treas. report to the club members. GROUNDS COMMITTEE REPORT:

Ken brought up old business. Ken wanted to talk about club house repairs. Glen, Ken and Ricky stopped by the field today and discuss bathroom door placements. Glen took measurements in the club house and made a material list for the repairs.

Ken brought up that we need to set up a general work day to get these things done. A general work day of March 13, 2010 was voted on and accepted. Several things were discussed to be done that day - repairs to both bathrooms, cleaning and throwing out items that are inside the club house which are no longer working or needed, and trash in general. There are three items that are available to whoever wants them, two grills and one stove, all items are non working. Items will be taken to the dump by the end of that day if someone doesn't want them. Ken noted that the club house also needs painting inside and outside.

It was voted by club members to spend no more than a \$1,000 for club house repairs.
