Our Vice President Roy Smith opened the meeting promptly at 3:05PM

### **GROUNDS COMMITTEE REPORT:**

Roy asked for a report from the grounds committee. Ricky mentioned that he started a 2 ½ foot wide buffer zone at the edge of the flight line. It should give a visual reference to the edge of the flightline as the line of lime will disappear over time. As the grass grows higher, it will be a safety stop for a run-a-way plane taxiing towards the parking area. There will be openings cut in the buffer zone to taxi planes in and out of the runway.

NOTE: Grass cutting schedule was forgotten, so we need volunteers to cut for the rest of the month of June. Please contact me to let me know what week you would like to cut the field. The dates are June 10, June 17, and June 24. These dates are on Thursdays, but the field could be cut on Friday if you like. This should carry us to the next meeting.
